Painting: Personal and Powerful, fall and spring semesters, three credit, Continuing Education. This 300 level (advanced) course addresses the goal of creating more personal and powerful painting by looking at: content, composition, color, surface as well as materials and craft. This class is the most popular painting elective among MSAE candidates.
- 2007** *Drawing with Color*, spring semester, three credit Studio Foundation course. This freshman level course focused on the fundamentals of drawing from observation and the basics of working with color. Excercises, assignments and individual projects focused on skill development and experimentation. Students worked with oil sticks, goache and found materials on a variety of surfaces.
- 2006** *Painting Majors Section*, spring semester, six credit sophomore course for painting majors. Focused on individual projects, and regular sessions with the model. Skill development, disciplined work habits, and expanding knowledge of contemporary painting were the goals
